## THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF FRASER LAKE BYLAW 692, 2008

Being a bylaw to temporarily prohibit the installation of outdoor solid fuel combustion appliances pending investigation of this matter more fully

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Fraser Lake has the authority pursuant to the Community Charter to regulate in regard to the protection, promotion or preservation of the health of individuals and the maintenance of sanitary conditions in the municipality

AND WHEREAS in June 2000, the Canadian Council of Ministers of Environment (CCME), except Quebec, adopted the Canada-wide Standards for Particulate Matter (PM2.5) and Ozone

AND WHEREAS research indicates that wood smoke is a significant contributor to PM2.5 levels which pose significant health risks

AND WHEREAS at this time there are no regulations for emissions on outdoor solid fuel combustion appliances

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Fraser Lake would like to regulate outdoor solid fuel combustion appliances but would like sufficient time for staff to consult with the Ministry of Environment and investigate the matter more fully

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Fraser Lake, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Village of Fraser Lake Outdoor Solid Fuel Combustion Appliances Control Bylaw 692, 2008.
- 2. No person shall install an outdoor solid fuel combustion appliance as of the adoption date of this bylaw.
- 3. This bylaw shall not create a duty of the Village of Fraser Lake, its officers, its employees, inspectors or person acting on its behalf pursuant to this bylaw concerning enforcement or failure to enforce any matter contained in this bylaw.
