

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Reservoir Fill Line, Utilities and Road Upgrades

July 28th, 2025

Dear Resident,

This notice is to inform you of the next phase of construction in your neighborhood. Work is continuing on Carrier Crescent and Tunasa Crescent with the installation of the new supply and distribution watermains. Additionally, a second crew will begin the sanitary sewer install on Tunasa Drive starting today, Monday, July 28th. Please note there will be an increase in construction equipment and crew as we continue progression with the project.

This week, the following activities are scheduled:

- Mainline install/backfill on Carrier Crescent from Tunasa Drive onto Tunasa Crescent
- Water services on Tunasa Drive
- Sanitary Sewer install on Tunasa Drive

Please note that driveway access may be temporarily restricted while work is underway. Our Community Liaison, Nichole, will notify affected residents in advance. If you have any questions regarding the road closures, kindly contact Nichole at **778-694-2117**.

For your safety, stay well clear of the worksite and all equipment at all times. Do not approach or enter the active construction zone. The road behind Mouse Mountain Elementary School is being used as a haul route for material. Please avoid this area during working hours Monday to Saturday 7am-5pm. If you need to pass near the active construction zone, please ask Nichole or another liaison for assistance.

Continue placing garbage bins curbside as usual—our Dawson team will ensure they remain accessible for collection. Garbage cans should be out Tuesday night or before 7am on Wednesday morning.
