

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Reservoir Fill Line, Utilities and Road Upgrades

November 3rd, 2025

Dear Resident,

This notice is to inform you of the next phase of construction in your neighborhood. Work is continuing on Tunasa Drive, Carrier Crescent, Tunasa Crescent, and across from the Village Office. with fire hydrant installs, ditching, finalizing temporary roads, and cleaning up for the winter.

This week, the following activities are scheduled:

- Fire hydrant installs along Tunasa Drive, at 518 Tunasa Drive, 458 Tunasa Drive, and across from the village office.

*** THERE WILL BE MACHINES BLOCKING THE ROADS IN THESE AREAS WHILE INSTALLING FIRE HYDRANTS. PLEASE PAY CLOSE ATTENTION WHERE WORK IS HAPPENING ***

- Ditching, finalizing temporary road, and cleaning up for the winter along Tunasa Drive,
 Carrier Crescent, and Tunasa Crescent.
- There will be no further water shut downs this year.

Due to unforeseen circumstances and challenges with backfill material, the following scope of work will be postposed until 2026. More details will be provided in the coming weeks regarding winterization of the project.

- Completion of storm including catch basins and lawn drains
- Road subgrade excavation and graveling
- Curbs and sidewalks
- Asphalt paving

Please note that driveway access may be temporarily restricted while work is underway. Our Community Liaison, Nichole, will notify affected residents in advance. If you have any questions regarding the road closures, kindly contact Nichole at **778-694-2117**.

For your safety, stay well clear of the worksite and all equipment at all times. Do not approach or enter the active construction zone. The road behind Mouse Mountain Elementary School is being used as a haul route for material. Please avoid this area during working hours Monday to Saturday 7am-5pm. If you need to pass near the active construction zone, please ask Nichole or another liaison for assistance.

Please avoid touching any valves or pressure test trees as they can be harmful when played with.

Continue placing garbage bins curbside as usual—our Dawson team will ensure they remain accessible for collection. Garbage cans should be out Tuesday night or before 7am on Wednesday morning.



We understand the road conditions have been challenging. Our crews are doing their best to maintain safe and drivable access for residents throughout the construction period. However, due to fluctuating weather conditions—particularly rain—there may be times when surfaces are rough or muddy. Please drive slowly and carefully through the area, and we thank you for bearing with us as we work to improve the long-term infrastructure.

Please note that the road construction will not be fully completed this season. With colder weather approaching, we have received questions and concerns about how the roads will be left for winter. Our plan is to leave the roadway in a stable, graded, and passable condition until full paving and completion resume in the spring. We will ensure any exposed or soft areas are properly addressed to support winter maintenance such as snow clearing and sanding.
