

Nomination packages for the 2026-2030 term of office for the Village of Fraser Lake Council are now available at the Village of Fraser Lake Municipal Office located at 210 Carrier Crescent, Fraser Lake, British Columbia.

Nominations will be accepted for:

- One (1) Mayor; and
- Four (4) Councillors.

Nomination packages will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person at the Village of Fraser Lake Municipal Office between the dates of September 1st, 2026 at 9:00AM and September 11th, 2026 at 4:00PM.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 17th, 2026;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed September 1st – September 11th, 2026; and
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act, for the 2026 General Local Election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:
