VOTING DATES AND LOCATIONS

GENERAL VOTING DAY will be held Saturday, October 17th, 2026, between 8:00 am and 8:00 pm at the Mouse Mountain Elementary School located at 266 Taluk Avenue.

ADVANCE VOTING will be held on:

Wednesday, October 7th, 2026
Between 8:00AM – 8:00PM
and
Wednesday, October 14th, 2026
Between 8:00AM – 8:00PM

Both Advanced voting opportunities will be held at the Village of Fraser Lake Municipal Office located at 210 Carrier Crescent, Fraser Lake, British Columbia.

A **SPECIAL VOTING OPPORTUNITY** will be held for the residents of Silver Birch Lodge the at the time of voting, as follows:

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. In order to register at the time of voting, you will be required complete the application form available at the voting place and to make a declaration that you meet the requirements to be registered as set out below:

RESIDENT ELECTORS:

To register as a resident elector you must:

- be 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 17th, 2026;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- be a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- be a resident of the Village of Fraser Lake on the day of registration (at time of voting); and
- not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS:

To register as a non-resident property elector you must:

- be 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 17th, 2026;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- be a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- be a registered owner of real property in the Village of Fraser Lake for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- not be entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and not otherwise disqualified by law.

In addition, for non-resident property electors:

- The only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust.

- If more than one person is registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.
- In addition, in order to register at time of voting:
 - To register, resident electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.
 - To register, non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, written consent from the other property owners.

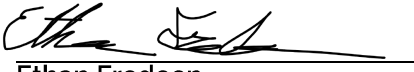
MAIL BALLOT VOTING

REQUESTING A MAIL BALLOT PACKAGE:

Qualified resident electors and non-resident property electors may vote by mail. To receive a mail ballot package, an eligible elector must complete an Application to Vote by Mail Ballot:

- Apply no later than Friday, October 5, 2026 if you would like the package mailed.
- Apply no later than Thursday, October 15, 2026 if you intend to pick up the package at the Village Office.
- Mail ballot packages are expected to be available on or about September 29, 2026. Please allow a minimum 48-hour turnaround time for packages to be prepared for pickup.
- Completed ballots and supporting documentation must be received at Village Office no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, October 16, 2026, or hand-delivered to the Chief Election Officer at Mouse Mountain School, 266 Taluk Ave, Fraser Lake, no later than 8:00 p.m. on General Voting Day, Saturday, October 17, 2026.
- Applications may be submitted by email, regular mail, in person, or by fax. If faxing, please call or email to confirm receipt. Packages may be mailed, picked up by the voter, or picked up by a designated person who completes the required declaration.

Those electors who may require some assistance as a result of physical challenges are invited to contact the Chief Election Officer as soon as possible to facilitate their voting experiences.
